

On behalf of the Alabama State Port Authority board of directors and management team, I am writing to support the Alabama Department of Transportation's MEGA Grant application through the U.S. Department of Transportation to support the I-10 Mobile River Bride and Bayway project. The Alabama State Port Authority is the statutory agency over navigation at Alabama's only deep-water seaport, the Port of Mobile. The Port Authority also owns the public seaport facilities that represents approximately forty-five percent of the total cargo volume moving through the Port of Mobile. The Port of Mobile is currently ranked the 11th largest U.S. seaport in total trade averaging 58 million tons annually.

The I-10 Mobile River Bridge and Bayway project is a critical transportation infrastructure project that will improve mobility, safety, security, and efficiency along the I-10 corridor in the Northern Gulf of Mexico states. This corridor connects both public travel and commerce tied to eight states. The corridor also serves as a connector to northbound interstate systems that reach markets in the Southeast and Midwest U.S. markets. The South Alabama region and the Port of Mobile is experiencing tremendous growth necessitating the need for new infrastructure to address capacity and fluidity of both citizens and interstate commerce.

The public and private seaport terminals at the Port of Mobile are key users of the I-10 corridor. The cargo and vessel activity at the port contribute over 161,000 jobs and \$26 billion in economic value in Alabama alone. The Port of Mobile's growth is tied to organic regional investments in retail/distribution, advanced manufacturing, agribusiness, and mining. The seaport has served as an important gateway into key U.S. markets under the nation's supply chain crisis providing relief to shippers traditionally dependent on West and East coast seaport gateways. As the nation and Congress tackles logistics and infrastructure in our nation, shippers

have permanently shifted into Mobile to ease congestion and service critical supply chains to keep American businesses competitive. It is equally important to note that Congress and the Administration have recently invested in Mobile's seaport infrastructure to service larger ocean-going vessels calling North American seaports, and in its rail and air cargo infrastructure. The missing piece is vital and necessary improvement to the I-10 corridor.

It is our hope that the U.S. Department of Transportation recognizes the importance of the I-10 corridor at Mobile to the national freight mobility strategy and awards this grant request to the Alabama Department of Transportation. The Alabama State Port Authority stands ready to address questions or provide additional information in support of this critical infrastructure project.





As a unified congressional delegation, we write in support of the State of Alabama's application to the Department of Transportation (DOT) to receive a Mega Grant, also known as the National Infrastructure Project Assistance program.

The I-10 Mobile River Bridge and Bayway project is not in every congressional district in Alabama; however, it is a critical piece of transportation infrastructure to the entire State, region, and nation. I-10 connects eight states, many of the country's major cities and seaports, and serves as a primary transportation artery for both travel and commerce throughout the United States.

Currently, to traverse the Mobile River and Mobile Bay on I-10, the majority of traffic must first utilize the Wallace and Bankhead tunnels in Mobile, each built more than 50 years ago and currently three times over the originally constructed capacity. Traffic must then cross a roughly 7.5 mile bridge across Mobile Bay, which was also constructed more than 50 years ago. Like the tunnels, this bridge is over capacity and not built to current safety and environmental standards.

Moreover, due to safety regulations, all hazardous cargo is unable to use the current tunnels and therefore must move via a state highway that runs through the historic and disadvantaged community of Africatown. The new Mobile River Bridge and Bayway project will add needed capacity for all travelers as well as divert the majority of traffic onto the new infrastructure, including hazardous cargo away from Africatown, creating a safer and more efficient route for all.

Much progress on the project has been made in recent months. With continued support and cooperation with local officials, the project is in its strongest position to date. The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) has acquired all the needed right of way to construct the project. Additionally, ALDOT has selected the main design-build teams to construct this large and complex endeavor. These teams are conducting field surveying and geotechnical work as we move toward an anticipated construction start date at the end of this year or early next year.

We are appreciative of DOT's designation of this project as one worthy of additional technical support from the Build America Bureau within DOT. It is our understanding that these conversations between ALDOT and DOT have been fruitful, leading to further advancements in the project itself.

Therefore, as elected members of the Alabama congressional delegation, we hope that DOT gives full, fair, and favorable consideration to the State of Alabama's application for this important project. Thank you for your time and attention to this matter.
